

Martin Russ

Martin Russ became Managing Director of AustriaTech in 2011. AustriaTech is the “Explorative Mobility Transformation Agency” of the Austrian Ministry of Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology and follows a long-term strategy towards sustainable transport and mobility services and solutions, like Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS), Automated and Connected Mobility and e-mobility. The federal agency works in partnership with Austrian infrastructure operators, mobility service providers, the industry, as well as research facilities and public authorities.

Martin Russ studied Regional and Transportation Planning at Vienna Technical University. As a consultant and transport engineer he gained broad experience in transportation and mobility planning and mobility technologies. From 2005 to 2008 he was responsible for the Austrian Transport Technology Research Program at the Austrian Research Promotion Agency (FFG). Between 2008 and 2011, he was senior advisor for innovation and technology at the cabinet of the Minister of Transport, Innovation and Technology.

In addition he is a member of the coordinating committee of [European ITS Nationals](#), acts as chair of the European Network of ITS Associations, and co-chairs the topic of digital infrastructure within the trilateral WG on CAD. Martin Russ is also the secretary general of the ITS Austria. Since July 2019 he is part of the Mission Board for Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities within the Horizon Europe research program.
