Martin Böhm is the leader of the Business Unit Digital Infrastructure & Data for Mobility at AustriaTech – "Explorative Mobility Transformation Agency" of the Austrian Ministry of Transport. In this context he advises the Austrian Ministry of Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Innovation and Technology as an expert in the field of "Intelligent Transport Systems" (ITS) in mobility-related issues and is responsible for the implementation of the ITS Directive in Austria.

Another focus of his work is the supervision and coordination of the ITS Austria platform (www.digitalvernetztmobil.at). As part of the platform, transport infrastructure operators, BMK and AustriaTech are working together on new mobility solutions with a focus on mobility-as-service (MaaS) and C-ITS.

Furthermore, in the role of the Secretary-General of the C-Roads Platform (<u>www.c-roads.eu</u>), Böhm is responsible for the harmonization and interoperability of the roadside deployment of the C-ITS infrastructure and led the international working group "Big Data for Road Owners" at the World Road Conference PIARC (www.piarc.org) with a focus on data access, data processing and service generation.

Martin Böhm is Master of Science (Geography) and Master of Science (Traffic Telematics Management). After completing his studies, he worked ten years at NavTech (now named Here), a manufacturer of digital road maps, before switching to AustriaTech in 2006.
